Scholarship schemes available to the students

I. Uttar Pradesh Scholarship: Government of Uttar Pradesh Scholarship scheme provides financial assistance to the students who are domicile of Uttar Pradesh and fulfill other eligibility criteria. The eligibility criteria will vary from one scheme to another. For further details please visit the website www.scholarship.up.nic.in.

II. AICTE- Scholarship:

- 1. Prime Minister Special Scholarship Scheme:** PMSSS is a central Government scheme being implemented by AICTE to provide quality education with an aim to equip J&K youths with technical knowledge, skills, experience and training for higher academic level/ profession. The candidate who is domicile of Jammu and Kashmir and whose family income is not more than 8 lakh per annum during the preceding financial year are eligible for applying scholarship. - 2. Pragati Scholarship Scheme for Girls Student. :** The candidate should be admitted to 1st year of Degree/Diploma course in any of the AICTE approved Institution of respective year through Centralized Admission process of the State/Central Government. Two Girls Child per family are eligible, who's family income is not more than 8 lakh per annum during the preceding financial year. The selection of candidate will be made on merit on the basis of qualifying examination to peruse the respective Technical Degree course from any of the AICTE approved institution. - 3. Saksham Scholarship Scheme for specially abled student. :** Saksham Scholarship is a MHRD Scheme being implemented by AICTE aimed at providing encouragement and support to specially-abled children to pursue technical education. This is an attempt to give every young student, who is otherwise specially-abled, the opportunity to study further and prepare for a successful future through technical education/ knowledge. Specially Abled Student, having disability of not less than 40% and family income not more than 8 lakh per annum during the preceding financial year. The selection of candidate will be made on merit basis of qualifying examination to peruse the respective Technical Degree course from any of the AICTE approved institution. 4. **Post Graduate Scholarship for Single Girl Child:** Girl students who are admitted in the first year of PG courses in the following Universities / Colleges and happen to be the only girl child in the family. The scheme is applicable to such single girl child who has taken admission in regular, full-time first year Masters Degree course in any designated university or a post graduate college. III. **National Scholarship.gov.in :**

1. **Merit-cum-means Scholarship for Professional & Technical Courses :**

Scholarship will be awarded to the students who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh. The scheme is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the website i.e. [www.scholarship.gov.in.](http://www.scholarship.gov.in)

2. **Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students.**

Students who are above 80 percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent and pursuing regular courses in Colleges/Institutions recognized by All India Council of Technical Education, UGC Act, 1956 and respective regulatory authorities and not availing benefit of any other scholarship scheme including State run scholarship schemes/Fee waiver and reimbursement scheme are eligible under the scheme. 3. **Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme For Central Armed Police Forces**

And Assam Rifles.: Wards/Widows of deceased/retired/serving pursuing first professional degree programme in the field of Engineering, Medical. Government service and Wards of Ex-CAPFs & AR personnel in receipt of Gallantry Awards. Having minimum 60% marks in Minimum Entry Qualification (MEQ) i.e. 10+2/Diploma/Graduation or equivalent It will be the sole responsibility of the applicant to make sure that he/she is eligible to apply and fulfills all the conditions prescribed for the scholarship.
